

EMERGENCY SHIPHANDLING PROCEDURES FOR PILOTS

Objectives:	Update and refresh the necessary knowledge to ensure optimal execution of the various procedures used during emergency manoeuvres.
Duration:	18 hours (2½ days)

Prerequisites:	Holding a pilot's license or being in the process of acquiring such a license.
Preferred teaching strategies:	Mainly practical. Brief theoretical explanations followed by exercises on the multidisciplinary navigation simulator.
Skill enhancement activities:	Theoretical and practical. Hands-on experience using the navigation simulator.
	Discussions among the participants encouraged during debriefing sessions.
Certification:	Issuance of a MSRC training certificate.
