EMERGENCY SHIPHANDLING PROCEDURES FOR PILOTS **(MU-025-018-ENG)**

Objectives:	Update and refresh the necessary knowledge to ensure optimal execution of the various procedures used during emergency maneuvers
Duration:	2½ to 3 days
Schedule:	Begins at 8:30 a.m. <i>The timetable can be adjusted according to certain constraints (travelling, etc.).</i>
<i>Prerequisites:</i>	<i>Holding a pilot's license or being in the process of acquiring such a license.</i>
Preferred teaching strategies:	Mainly practical. Brief theoretical explanations followed by exercises on the multidisciplinary navigation simulator.
Skill enhancement activities:	Theoretical and practical. Hands-on experience using the navigation simulator. Discussions among the participants encouraged during debriefing sessions.
Notes about the exercises:	Standard emergency maneuvers, emergency stops, turns and use of anchors. Hands-on experience in various emergency situations, such as engine failure, steering failure, collision, stranding, etc.
